Regional differences in entrepreneurship, technology, input and spending effects across Greece: 2001-11

The study empirically analyses Greece's regional GDPs in terms of labor, capital and investment variables across six sectors, and public spending variables from 2000 to 2011 in Greece, in order to estimate the coefficients, the regional total (entrepreneurship-and-technology) productivity factors, and aid in development policy planning. It finds evidence of regional differences in entrepreneurship and technology, different labor and spending effects across regions, and different capital and investment effects across sectors.
